

**OPERATIONS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE
SENECA COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION
FISCAL YEAR 2010**

The Seneca County Economic Development Corporation (EDC) is a not-for-profit Corporation created by the Seneca County Industrial Development Agency (IDA). The mission of the Seneca County EDC is to promote, attract and encourage economic development in Seneca County that results in the creation of employment opportunities, enhances the quality of life and general prosperity for Seneca County residents.

The Seneca County EDC is a volunteer three-member Board of Directors appointed by the Seneca County IDA. It is supported financially by the Seneca County IDA and its own project administration leasing/licensing fees. Operating staff are employed by the Seneca County IDA and provide support for EDC activities.

The Seneca County EDC assisted with the following projects in 2010:

- The Seneca County EDC continued to administer the Main Street Program for facade and interior renovation projects in downtown Seneca Falls.
- The Seneca County EDC approved License Agreements for various law enforcement agencies and private sports car clubs to utilize the Depot Airfield parcel.
- The Seneca County EDC approved an Access Agreement for a photographer to visit the Depot Conservation Area.
- The Seneca County EDC approved License Agreements for three property owners for depot property continuous to the Depot Airfield.
- The Seneca County EDC processed New York State Empire State Development Grant contracts and reimbursements for Hillside Family of Services for \$500,000. and Seneca County IDA for \$86,501.71.
- The Seneca County EDC approved a License Agreement for the storage of empty rail cars on the former Depot.
